## Champagne and Sparkling Wine

Champagne is the celebration drink "par excellence" and makes a first rate aperitif. Valued for its unique properties for some centuries, it has spawned many colourful characters and legends. Britain is the world's largest consumer of champagne after France itself and constantly amazes the champagne houses with its thirst for mature vintage champagne. Most of the houses consider the wine ready when they release it but the Gout Anglais is for greater maturity.

Most wines are a blend of chardonnay, pinot noir and pinot meunier in the proportions chosen to suit the style of a particular house. Some 100% chardonnay wines are produced and labelled blanc de blancs. Other areas of France produce sparkling wines, the most successful using the "methode champenoise" now labelled "methode traditionnelle" to protect the name "champagne".

Many parts of the New World are producing high quality sparkling wines, especially those using the "methode traditionnelle". Indeed, some champagne houses have invested heavily in the New World projects. Greenpoint from Australia is the result of a major investment by Moet et Chandon and is a very fine wine indeed.

# Bordeaux

Bordeaux forms the worlds' largest fine wine growing area. Its red wine, better known as Claret, is probably the most famous red wine in the world. Dominated in the minds of the public by the prestigious classed growth chateaus of the Medoc and the great chateaus of Pomerol and St Emilion, it also encompasses many cru borgeois estates and petit chateaus capable of producing fine quality wines. The worlds' greatest sweet wines, Sauternes, also come from Bordeaux. For red wines the principal grape varieties are Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Merlot; for white wines, Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon. Classed growth Clarets from the best years are capable of long ageing, resulting in wines offering exquisite complexity of aroma and flavour.

## Burgundy

Burgundy is an area which has much greater importance than its' size would imply. It is much smaller than Bordeaux and has few aristocratic show places. Essentially there are only two grape varieties to worry about – Pinot Noir for the red wines and Chardonnay for the white, with the notable exception of Gamay in the Beaujolais. The finest whites come from Chablis and the vineyards of the southern Cote de Beaune. The reds come from the Cote de Nuits. The Cote de Beaune and the Cote de Nuits form the Cote d'Or, a narrow line of hillsides running from Dijon to Chalon, where the soils, the aspect of the vineyard to the sun and the hand of man can produce some of the most sublime creations in the world of wine. The Maconais and Cote Chalonnaise produce cheaper forms of Burgundy from the same grape varieties and provide good value. The area of the Beaujolais produces a fruit-filled, easy to drink wine for pleasure. Its more serious wines, named after one of ten villages entitled their own appellation, have more weight and style and character. Chablis has made strides in recent years as improved vineyard techniques have made production in this very northerly vignoble less uncertain. The premier and grand cru wines are the finest and have a flinty character, allied to fruit and richness, which is most attractive. Good examples will age magnificently as well as giving much pleasure when young.

## Rhone Valley

The Rhone vineyards fall broadly into two groups, the north where the vines share the terraced hills with nuts and peach trees and the steep valleys are the home of the Syrah and Shiraz grape, names like Crozes Hermitage promise intense, fruity wines fading to spice and pepper, and the south where the countryside flattens and the vines are planted in flat fields of smooth round stones, as a rule these wines are made, not from one grape variety, but from anything between two and thirteen. The resultant wines can be light and fruity if made by modern methods or if more traditional in character, full-bodied, deep coloured, taking up to ten years to mature.
